we can accept

Appliances: Must be less than 5 years old, in perfect working condition.

Furniture: All furniture must be in excellent condition. Mattresses must be new & in original packaging.

Windows: Must be double pane and in the frame. Blinds subject to approval.

Electrical: Wire, outlets, sockets, hardware

Hardware: Complete sets of door hardware, hinges, nails, screws, fasteners, hangers, connectors, etc.

Plumbing: White or off white toilets *without* seats, stainless steel and porcelain kitchen sinks, pedestal or drop-in bathroom sinks, fiberglass bathtubs, miscellaneous plumbing hardware. *No chips, cracks, rust or water damage.*

Cabinets: Must have all doors and drawers. *No structural or water damage.*

Lighting: Lamps, indoor and outdoor lighting, ceiling fans

Building supplies: Architectural Items, mantels, columns, stained and leaded glass windows.

Flooring: Carpet remnants and padding, area rugs, hardwood flooring, vinyl and ceramic tile. *No visible wear, tear, stains, odors, chips or broken pieces.*

Lumber: Must be free of all nails and screws & 5' in length, sheetgoods (particle board, paneling, plywood) must be half sheets. Trim and molding must be at least 5'.

Doors: Pre-hung/slabs, exterior/interior, storm doors, sliding glass patio doors (in frame). *No rotted wood, broken glass, peeling paint, or heights above 84".*

Paint: Must be unopened or at least 3/4 full. Samples, pints, quarts, gallons and 5-gallon buckets of latex paint only. *No rust on cans.*

Miscellaneous: Home décor; knick-knacks; dishes; cookware; wall art; shutters; gas logs; free-standing wood stoves; window AC units; hand and power tools (in good working condition); palletized brick, glass blocks, and stone pavers; solid surface countertops, books.
